| <p>DRESS UNIFORM (Wednesday)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Red collared polo with the SCES shield logo. ● Navy Slacks/Chino style pants or shorts, jumper, skirt or skort. | <p>PE/ATHLETICS (Middle & High School Only)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Tennis shoes, plain red t-shirt and navy athletic shorts or joggers must be brought to school everyday to dress out for PE/Athletics class. ● Workout attire may not be worn outside of scheduled PE/Athletic periods. |
| <p>SCES SPIRIT DAY (Friday)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● SCES Polo, SCES T-shirt or school appropriate college T-shirt. ● Pants or shorts in denim, khaki or navy. ● Friday is a proper uniform day if a student is not dressed for SCES Spirit Day. | <p>OUTERWEAR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● SCES sweatshirt without hood. ● Navy blazer with school logo. ● Navy, red or gray fleece. (plain or with a school logo) ● Navy, red, or white cardigan sweater plain or with school logo. ● On cold weather days any winter gear such as hats, gloves, heavy jackets may be worn outside the building only. |

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Land's End carries the school's plaid for ties, skirts, jumpers and skorts. Navy blazers may be purchased through Land's End.
- Long sleeve shirts in white, red, or navy may be worn under uniform shirts.
- Ties in school plaid may be worn with white button down collared shirts with St. Cyprian's shield logo (required).
- All shorts, skirts, skorts, and jumpers must be no shorter than four inches above mid knee or no longer than mid-knee. All official measurements will be done discreetly in the office.
- Any student wearing a skirt, jumper or dress must wear modesty shorts, tights or leggings to cover undergarments. Leggings or tights must be in colors of red, navy or white. Leggings/tights are not to be worn as pants.
- Only rubber soled shoes are allowed, and must have enclosed heels and toes. Tennis shoes are also permissible. Socks must be worn with all shoes. Socks must be red, navy or white.
- During the school year there will be free dress days offered for students to be allowed a choice of clothing acceptable to the school environment. Please comply with general safety and modesty standards.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Exposed undergarments, e.g. camisoles, tank tops, sports bras.
- Unnatural hair colors or highlights (blue, pink, green, purple, etc.) or extreme hairstyles.
- Extreme jewelry. (example: spiked bracelets/necklaces, dog collar jewelry, chains, body piercings, etc.)
- Sweatshirts, hoodies, flannel shirts, jerseys or t-shirts worn over school polo.
- Spandex, leggings, jeggings, or other form-fitting pants, skirts, or dresses. Leggings/tights may not be worn as pants.
- Athletic shorts, joggers, sweatpants and tights may not be worn as uniform bottoms.
- Oversized, baggy, ripped or torn apparel.
- Spaghetti straps, sleeveless tops, hats.
- Sandals, open toed shoes, crocs, water shoes. Rainboots may not be worn in the classroom.
- No heels on boots or shoes higher than ½ inch.
- Headphones, earbuds or airpods are not to be worn unless permitted by the teacher for instructional purposes.
- Student attire that distracts, disrupts, or interferes with the learning environment and school safety is prohibited.

**The final determination of a student being out of dress code rests with the Head of School.
When a student is out of dress code a parent will be notified to bring appropriate attire.**
