

School supplies are provided for all students with the following exceptions.

3K and 4K

- No Back Pack (SCES will provide a school bag for each child)
- Pair of Rubber Boots clearly labeled with student's name
- Reusable Water Bottle (20oz or smaller, leak proof, clearly labeled with student's name/grade. To avoid damage to books and papers, water bottles are not be placed in school bag)
- Small Rest Mat and Small Cover w/ TRAVEL SIZED PILLOW ONLY!!
- Change of clothes in a large baggie labeled with child's name. (Underwear, socks and a Dress Uniform- Red Shirt & Navy Bottom)

5K

- No Back Pack (SCES will provide a school bag for each child)
- Pair of Rubber Boots clearly labeled with student's name
- Pair of headphones (no earbuds & NO BLUETOOTH) clearly labeled with student's name
- Reusable Water Bottle (20oz or smaller, leak proof, clearly labeled with student's name/grade. To
 avoid damage to books and papers, water bottles are not be placed in school bag)

1st – 5th Grade

- Back Pack clearly labeled with student's name
- Pair of Rubber Boots clearly labeled with student's name
- Pair of headphones (no earbuds & NO BLUETOOTH) clearly labeled with student's name
- Reusable Water Bottle (20oz or smaller, leak proof, clearly labeled with student's name/grade. To avoid damage to books and papers, water bottles are not be placed in backpack)

6th - 10th Grade

- Back Pack clearly labeled with student's name
- Pair of headphones or earbuds (NO BLUETOOTH) clearly labeled with student's name
- PE Clothes: Tennis shoes, Red T-shirt, and Navy Shorts (no more that 4 inches above the knee).
- Reusable Water Bottle (20oz or smaller, leak proof, clearly labeled with student's name/grade. To avoid damage to books and papers, water bottles are not be placed in backpack)

Please note that teachers may require additional items for special projects throughout the school year.

^{*}Rubber Boots are required for all students 3K-5th grade as we spend time weekly in the Outdoor Learning Center, as well as, on the playground when the ground is wet after rainy days. This will help protect student's school shoes from water, dirt and various other encounters that happen while exploring education in nature.
